An Act to amend the Arbitration Act 1996

[3 June 1998]

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of New Zealand as follows:

1. Short Title and commencement—(1) This Act may be cited as the Arbitration Amendment Act 1998, and is part of the Arbitration Act 1996 (“the principal Act”).

(2) This Act is deemed to have come into force on 1 July 1997.

2. First Schedule amended—Article 7 (1) of the First Schedule of the principal Act is amended by omitting the expression “section 9”, and substituting the expression “section 11”.

3. Fourth Schedule amended—The Fourth Schedule of the principal Act is amended by omitting the item relating to the Evidence Amendment Act (No. 2) 1980, and substituting the following item:

“1980, No. 27—The Evidence Amendment Act (No. 2) 1980 (R.S. Vol. 28, p. 505)	By repealing the definitions of the terms ‘Court’ and ‘proceeding’ in section 2 (1).”
