**An Act to amend the Agricultural and Pastoral Societies
Act 1908** [23 December 1977]

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1. Short Title—This Act may be cited as the Agricultural and Pastoral Societies Amendment Act 1977, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Agricultural and Pastoral Societies Act 1908.

2. Application of money received from sale of land—Section 3 (1) of the Agricultural and Pastoral Societies Amendment Act 1912 is hereby amended by adding, after the words “acquisition of other land by the society”, the words “, or, in the case of land which, for the purposes of the Society, has been granted by the Crown or acquired from the Crown in exchange for land originally granted by the Crown, for such purposes as the Minister of Agriculture may approve and subject to such conditions as he may impose”.

This Act is administered in the Ministry of Agriculture and Fisheries.
