An Act to revive "The Agricultural Implement Manufacture, Title. Importation, and Sale Act, 1905." [23rd October, 1906.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Agricultural Implement short Title. Manufacture, Importation, and Sale Act Extension Act, 1906."

2. (1.) "The Agricultural Implement Manufacture, Importation, Continuation of and Sale Act, 1905," shall continue in operation and be deemed to have continued in operation as if section thirteen thereof had not been passed, until the thirty-first day of December, one thousand nine hundred and seven.

(2.) The said section thirteen is hereby repealed.
