**An Act to amend the Auckland Transport Board Act 1928**

[30 September 1960]

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

**1. Short Title**—This Act may be cited as the Auckland Transport Board Amendment Act 1960, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Auckland Transport Board Act 1928 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

**2. Filling of extraordinary vacancy**—The principal Act is hereby amended by inserting, after section 11, the following section:

“12. (1) In the event of an extraordinary vacancy in the office of a representative of any constituent district on the Board, the local authority of that district shall forthwith appoint some qualified person in his place as a representative of that district.

“(2) In the event of an extraordinary vacancy in the office of a representative of a combined district on the Board, the several local authorities of that combined district shall forthwith, by agreement among themselves, jointly appoint some qualified person in his place as a representative of that district.

“(3) If no such appointment as specified is made within two months after the happening of the vacancy, the Board may itself make the required appointment.

“(4) The member so appointed shall hold office only for the unexpired portion of the term of office of his predecessor.”

**3. Additional powers of Board**—The principal Act is hereby amended by inserting, after section 58, the following section:

“58A. The powers conferred upon the Board by this Act to carry on any business contemplated thereby shall be deemed to authorise it to carry on any business of an associated or similar nature and in particular any business or activities connected with the motor industry which can conveniently be carried on by it in the interests of the public.”
