**An Act to amend the Broadcasting Act 1976**

[23 December 1977]

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

**1. Short Title**—This Act may be cited as the Broadcasting Amendment Act (No. 2) 1977, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Broadcasting Act 1976 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

**2. Powers of Corporation in relation to property**—Section 46 of the principal Act is hereby amended by inserting, after paragraph (a), the following paragraph:

“(aa) With the consent of the local authority in which the road or street or reserve or the control thereof is vested, and subject to any conditions on which that consent is given, establish, instal, erect, alter, operate, and maintain relay stations on roads or streets or on reserves for road or street purposes, and the local authority shall have power, and be deemed always to have had power, to give such consent:”.
