An Act to amend the Births and Deaths Registration Act 1951 [27 November 1970]

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1. Short Title—This Act may be cited as the Births and Deaths Registration Amendment Act 1970, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Births and Deaths Registration Act 1951 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

2. Shortened forms of birth certificates—Section 39A of the principal Act (as inserted by section 3 of the Births and Deaths Registration Amendment Act 1953 and amended by section 5 of the Births and Deaths Registration Amendment Act 1955) is hereby further amended by repealing subsection (1), and substituting the following subsection:

“(1) Every certified copy of an entry of a birth or death under section 38 or section 39 of this Act shall be in the prescribed form. Any such form shall include only such particulars, and shall be used in such circumstances, as may be prescribed.”

3. Application of fines and fees—Section 51 of the principal Act is hereby amended by omitting the word “Minister”. and substituting the words “Secretary for Justice”.

This Act is administered in the Department of Justice.
