## An Act to amend the Chiropractors Act 1960

[1 December 1961]

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1. Short Title—This Act may be cited as the Chiropractors Amendment Act 1961, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Chiropractors Act 1960 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).
- 2. Commencement of principal Act—(1) Subsection (2) of section 1 of the principal Act is hereby amended by omitting the words "the first day of January, nineteen hundred and sixty-one", and substituting the words "the date one month after the date of the passing of the Chiropractors Amendment Act 1961".
- (2) The principal Act shall be deemed not to have come into force before the passing of this Act.
- 3. Constitution of Chiropractic Board—Section 3 of the principal Act is hereby amended by repealing subsection (2), and substituting the following subsection:

"(2) The Board shall consist of-

"(a) The Chairman, who shall be a barrister of the Supreme Court of New Zealand of at least seven years practice:

"(b) Two chiropractors to be nominated by the Association:

- "(c) Two persons to be nominated by the Minister of Justice, of whom one shall be a chiropractor."
- 4. Constitution of Chiropractic Disciplinary Committee—Subsection (2) of section 7 of the principal Act is hereby amended by omitting the words "Governor-General on the recommendation of the Minister of Justice", and substituting the word "Board".
- 5. Examination of chiropractors—Section 9 of the principal Act is hereby amended by inserting in paragraph (a) of subsection (1), after the word "Act", the words "or, in the absence of any such regulations prescribing examinations, as required by the Board".
- 6. Offences by unregistered persons—Section 26 of the principal Act is hereby amended by omitting from subsection (2) the words "first day of July, nineteen hundred and sixty-one", and substituting the words "date three months after the date of the commencement of this Act".
- 7. Annual practising certificates—Subsection (2) of section 28 of the principal Act is hereby amended by omitting the words "nineteen hundred and sixty-one", and substituting the words "nineteen hundred and sixty-two".
- 8. Application of fees and payment of expenses—(1) The principal Act is hereby amended by repealing section 33, and substituting the following section:

"33. All fees and other money received under this Act shall be paid to the Association, and all expenses incurred in the administration of this Act shall be paid by the Association."

(2) Section 8 of the principal Act is hereby consequentially amended by omitting the words "out of money appropriated by Parliament for the purpose".

This Act is administered in the Department of Justice.
