An Act to amend the Customs Act 1966

[31 August 1990]

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of New Zealand as follows:

1. Short Title and commencement—(1) This Act may be cited as the Customs Amendment Act (No. 2) 1990, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Customs Act 1966.

(2) Except as provided in section 3 (2) of this Act, this Act shall come into force on the day on which it receives the Royal assent.

2. Ninth Schedule to Customs Act 1966—For the avoidance of doubt, it is hereby declared that the repeal (by section 18 (2) of the Tariff Act 1988) of subsection (3) of section 5 of the Customs Amendment Act 1981 did not repeal or affect the Ninth Schedule to the Customs Act 1966 (as added by that subsection).

3. Refund of duty on imported motor vehicles—(1) Section 11 (1) of the Customs Amendment Act 1990 is hereby amended—

(a) By omitting from paragraph (a) the expression “1st day of April 1990”, and substituting the expression “22nd day of March 1989”:

- (b) By repealing paragraph (b).
- (2) Subsection (1) of this section shall be deemed to have come into force on the 25th day of July 1990.
