### 1887, No. 10.—*Local.*

**Title.** AN ACT to transfer to the Hospital Board of the North Canterbury Hospital District the Buildings used for the Purposes of the Christchurch Hospital, and the Grounds thereof or connected therewith. [19th December, 1887.]

**Preamble.** WHEREAS the lands described in the several Schedules hereto originally formed part of Hagley Park, adjoining to the City of Christchurch, and the lands in the First Schedule mentioned, consisting of five acres and two roods, more or less, were, under the authority of "The Christchurch Hospital Ordinance, 1863," retained out of the said park for a public hospital and grounds connected therewith :

And whereas all the remaining lands in the said Schedules described, together with other lands comprised within the said Hagley Park, were, by "The Public Domains Ordinance, 1872," of the former Province of Canterbury, declared to be a public domain, subject to "The Canterbury Public Domains Act, 1872," of the General Assembly; and whereas under the authority or supposed authority of the last-mentioned Act the then Superintendent of the aforesaid province permitted the occupation of the said remaining lands by the Canterbury Acclimatisation Society for the objects thereof :

And whereas the said society, in the month of July, one thousand eight hundred and seventy-three, with the concurrence of the Domain Board, then holding the delegated powers of the Superintendent under the Act of the General Assembly last mentioned, permitted the lands in the Second Schedule mentioned, containing one acre and thirty-two perches, more or less, to be occupied for the purposes of the Christchurch Hospital and the erection of a fever-ward thereon, and also the lands in the Third Schedule mentioned, containing one acre and thirty-four perches, more or less, to be also

occupied for the purposes of the Christchurch Hospital, as a kitchen-garden annexed thereto :

And whereas the said society further, in the month of July, one thousand eight hundred and seventy-five, did permit the lands in the Fourth Schedule mentioned, containing five acres two roods and thirty-two perches, more or less, to be occupied for the purposes of the Christchurch Hospital, as pleasure-gardens and recreation-grounds for the use of the patients thereof :

And whereas the several aforesaid acts of the said society and Domain Board were not authorised by law :

And whereas it is expedient that the lands appropriated as above mentioned for a fever ward should be appropriated for such purpose by law, and together with the lands in the First Schedule mentioned should be granted to the Board of the Hospital District having the control of the said hospital ; and that the other lands appropriated as above mentioned, for the purposes of the aforesaid hospital as kitchen-garden and pleasure-grounds for the inmates thereof, should be placed under the control of the said Board :

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

1. The Short Title of this Act is “The Christchurch Hospital Act, 1887.” Short Title.

2. The lands described in the First and Second Schedules hereto are hereby vested in the Board of the North Canterbury Hospital District for an estate in fee-simple, to be held by the said Board for the purposes of the Christchurch Hospital. Lands whereon hospital and fever ward constructed granted in fee to Board of North Canterbury Hospital District.

3. The lands described in the Third and Fourth Schedules hereto are hereby vested in the above-mentioned Board in trust for the purposes of a kitchen-garden and of pleasure-gardens and recreation-grounds respectively for the use of the inmates of the aforesaid hospital, and for no other purposes ; and so that the said Board shall not at any time erect, or permit to be erected, any buildings or constructions of any kind thereon, except such as may be approved by the Domain Board having the control of the lands in Hagley Park. Lands used as kitchen- and pleasure-gardens vested in Board, in trust, to be used for such purposes only.

## SCHEDULES.

Schedules.

### FIRST SCHEDULE.

ALL that parcel of land in the Provincial District of Canterbury, containing by admeasurement 5 acres 2 roods, more or less, being part of Hagley Park, situate in the Christchurch Survey District, and bounded towards the north by a creek running into the River Avon, west of and near to its intersection by Antigua Street ; towards the east by said river, also by Antigua Street 205 links ; towards the south-east and south-west by the Lincoln and Riccarton Roads, 1240 links ; and towards the west by a line bearing north 4° 37' west, 393 links : be all the aforesaid linkages more or less ; as the same is delineated on the plan deposited in the District Survey Office, Christchurch.

### SECOND SCHEDULE.

ALL that parcel of land in the Provincial District of Canterbury, containing by admeasurement 1 acre and 32 perches, more or less, being part of Hagley Park, situate in the Christchurch Survey District, and bounded towards the north-east by the creek which forms the northern boundary of the old hospital ground ; towards

the east by the said ground, 393 links; towards the south-west by the Riccarton Road, 408 links; and towards the north-west by a line bearing north  $13^{\circ} 52'$  east, 356 links: be all the aforesaid linkages more or less; as the same is delineated on the plan deposited in the District Survey Office, Christchurch.

#### THIRD SCHEDULE.

ALL that parcel of land in the Provincial District of Canterbury, containing by admeasurement 1 acre and 34 perches, more or less, being part of Hagley Park, situate in the Christchurch Survey District, and bounded towards the north-west by a right line bearing north  $13^{\circ} 52'$  east, being the production in a northerly direction of the north-western boundary of the proposed extension of the hospital grounds for a fever ward, 392 links; towards the north-east by a right line, 306 links; towards the south-east and east by right lines, 421 links and 30 links respectively; and towards the south by a creek running into the River Avon: as the same is delineated on the plan in the Survey Office, Christchurch.

#### FOURTH SCHEDULE.

ALL that parcel of land in the Provincial District of Canterbury, containing by admeasurement 5 acres 2 roods 32 perches, more or less, being part of Hagley Park, situate in the Christchurch Survey District, and bounded towards the north-east by the River Avon; towards the south by a creek running into the said River Avon, west of and near its intersection by Antigua Street; towards the west by a right line, 30 links; and towards the north-west by right lines, 556 links and 368 links respectively: as the same is delineated on the plan in the Survey Office, Christchurch.
