**CANTERBURY
ROADS ORDINANCE
AMENDMENT ACT
EXTENSION.**

AN ACT to extend the operation of "The Canterbury Roads Ordinance Amendment Act, 1877," in certain cases.

[1st September, 1880.]

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short Title.

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Canterbury Roads Ordinance Amendment Act Extension Act, 1880."

Provisions of "The Canterbury Roads Ordinance Amendment Act, 1877," to apply to petitions for annexation to contiguous district.

2. The provisions of "The Canterbury Roads Ordinance Amendment Act, 1877," shall extend to all cases in which a petition is presented under the seventh section of "The Canterbury Roads Ordinance, 1872," for annexing any part of a district to an adjoining or contiguous district.
