AN ACT to amend the Law relating to certain Securities and Contracts respecting Chattel Property. Title.
[10th June, 1887.]

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Chattel Securities Act 1880 Amendment Act, 1887." Short Title.

2. In this Act "special security" means any security, contract, or instrument given, entered into, or made under the provisions of Parts II., III., or IV. of "The Chattel Securities Act, 1880." Interpretation of a special security.

3. The provisions of sections three to seven, both inclusive, of "The Chattel Securities Act 1880 Amendment Act, 1883," shall not apply to a special security. Certain provisions of "The Chattel Securities Act 1880 Amendment Act, 1883," not to apply to a special security.

4. The provisions of the eightieth section of "The Bankruptcy Act, 1883," shall not apply to a special security. Also eightieth section of "The Bankruptcy Act, 1883."

5. This Act shall extend and apply to every deed, instrument, or contract in force executed, made, or entered into before the passing of this Act, and forming or intended to form a special security within the meaning of this Act: Provided that nothing herein shall affect any proceedings heretofore taken or now pending in any Court wherein the validity of any such special security shall have been or shall be in question.
