AN ACT to amend the Education Act, 1914.

Title.

[25th November, 1947

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Education Amendment Act, 1947, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Education Act, 1914 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

2. Section two of the Education Amendment Act, 1932-33, is hereby amended by inserting, after subsection eight, the following new subsection:—

“(8A) Notwithstanding anything in the foregoing provisions of this section, the Board may in making an appointment, by transfer or otherwise, to a vacant position in the secondary department of a district

high school or in an intermediate school or in an intermediate department appoint a person who is classified in accordance with regulations under the principal Act as a post-primary teacher.”

Section 4 of Education Amendment Act, 1938 (as to regulations relating to appointments of teachers in public schools), amended.

3. (1) Section four of the Education Amendment Act, 1938, is hereby amended as follows:—

(a) By adding to paragraph (c) the words “and the date before which the teacher is to be given notice of the intention to transfer him”:

(b) By omitting from paragraph (d) all words after the words “any position held by him”, and substituting the words “at a date specified in the regulations where the salary attached to that position by any regulations coming into force after the date so specified is less than the maximum salary and allowances receivable by him for that position on the date so specified”.

(2) The said section four is hereby further amended by adding thereto the following new paragraph:—

“(f) Providing for the fixing of rentals for teachers’ residences, the method of payment of such rentals, and the conditions of occupancy of such residences.”

4. (1) Section eighty-one of the principal Act, as amended by section eighteen of the Education Amendment Act, 1919, is hereby further amended as follows:—

(a) By repealing subsection one:

(b) By omitting from subsection two the words “Such residence”, and substituting the words “A teacher’s residence”.

(2) The Education Amendment Act, 1919, is hereby consequentially amended by omitting so much of the Third Schedule as relates to section eighty-one of the principal Act.

Section 33 of principal Act (as to funds of Board) amended.

5. Section thirty-three of the principal Act is hereby amended by omitting from subsection seven all words after the words “charging to any special fund”, and substituting the words “, by transfer to the General Fund, such charges for the administration of the special fund as the Minister approves”.

6. The Second Schedule to the principal Act is hereby amended by inserting in clause ten, after paragraph (b), the following new paragraph:—

“(bb) If the name of the elector is signed or otherwise marked thereon:”.
