## The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:

### 1 Title

- (1) This Act is the Explosives Amendment Act 2000.
- (2) In this Act, the Explosives Act 1957 is called “the principal Act”.

### 2 Commencement

This Act comes into force on the day after the date on which it receives the Royal assent.

### 3 New section 8 substituted

- (1) The principal Act is amended by repealing section 8, and substituting the following section:

#### “8 Inspectors of Explosives

The Secretary may appoint as many people to be Inspectors of Explosives as seems necessary for the purposes of this Act.”

- (2) Subsection (1) does not affect the status as an Inspector of Explosives of any person holding office immediately before the commencement of this section.

**4 Consequential amendment**

The Fifth Schedule of the Hazardous Substances and New Organisms Act 1996 is amended by adding the following item:

“Explosives Amendment Act 2000 (2000 No 63).”
