An Act to amend the Education Act 1989

[31 August 1990

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of New Zealand as follows:

1. Short Title and commencement—(1) This Act may be cited as the Education Amendment Act (No. 2) 1990, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Education Act 1989.

(2) Except as provided in sections 2 (3) and 2 (4) of this Act, this Act shall come into force on the day on which it receives the Royal assent.

2. Transitional operation of colleges of education and specialist institutions—(1) The Sixth Schedule to the Education Amendment Act 1990 is hereby amended—

(a) By omitting from the item relating to the Education Act 1964 the expression “67A to 67s, 67T to 69A”; and

(b) By omitting from the item relating to the Education Amendment Act (No. 2) 1974 the expression “9”.

(2) The following enactments are hereby repealed:

(a) Section 67A to 67s, and 67T to 69A, of the Education Act 1964:

- (3) Subsection (1) of this section shall be deemed to have come into force on the 23rd day of July 1990.
- (4) Subsection (2) of this section shall come into force on the 1st day of January 1991.
