Title. AN ACT to amend "The Education Act, 1904."
[8th November, 1904.]

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short Title. 1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Education Act Amendment Act, 1904"; and it shall form part of and be read together with "The Education Act, 1904" (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act").

Amendments of principal Act. 2. (1.) The principal Act is hereby amended as follows:—

(a.) As to section six thereof, by repealing the proviso to subparagraph (ii) of paragraph (b) thereof.

(b.) As to section fifty-nine thereof, by repealing the words "and Fifth Schedules," and substituting in lieu thereof the word "Schedule."

(c.) As to section sixty thereof, by repealing the proviso thereto.

(d.) As to section sixty-one thereof, by repealing the word "twenty," and inserting in lieu thereof the word "eight."

(e.) As to the Fourth Schedule thereto, by repealing Part I. and Part II. thereof, and inserting in lieu thereof the First Schedule to this Act.

(f.) By repealing the Fifth Schedule thereto.

(g.) By repealing the Sixth Schedule thereto, and inserting in lieu thereof the Second Schedule to this Act.

(2.) This section shall come into operation on the first day of January, one thousand nine hundred and five.

Powers of Governors of High Schools as corporate bodies. 3. Every Board of Governors of a High School constituted a body corporate by section eighty-nine of the principal Act shall have power to hold lands, may sue and be sued, and may do and suffer all such Acts and things as corporate bodies may do and suffer.

* Capitation is payable on the number in excess of the lower of the two numbers in the column "Average Attendance": for instance, the salary in a school of 21 is £114; in a school of 36, £152, M.; £141, F.; &c.

SALARIES OF PUPIL-TEACHERS.

First year, £20, with allowance of £10 if obliged to live away from home.
 Second " £30, " £10
 Third " £40, " £5

Fourth year, £50, with allowance of £5 if obliged to live away from home.
 Fifth " £50, " £5

The above scale is subject to the following modifications and conditions:—

- (a.) The number of male assistants must not exceed the number of female assistants (including the mistress).
- (b.) At least three out of the first six assistants in any school above 510 (exclusive of the mistress) must be females.
- (c.) A male assistant at £100 or a female assistant at £80 may be substituted for two pupil-teachers.
- (d.) Two pupil-teachers may be substituted for an assistant.
- (e.) Instead of an assistant, a pupil-teacher may be employed, £45 being added to the salary of another assistant.
- (f.) Instead of adding a pupil-teacher, a Board may add £35 to the salary of an assistant.

- (g.) Only one of the changes (d), (e), and (f) shall be allowed in schools not over 420, and only two in schools over 420.
- (h.) The total number of pupil-teachers in any education district must not be increased by such changes as (d) and (e) above the number allowed for such district by the scale.
- (i.) Any certificated teacher on the staff of a school in which pupil-teachers are employed may be required, without extra payment, to take part in the instruction of such pupil-teachers.
- (j.) A deduction of 10 per cent. from the salary as prescribed above shall be made in the case of every uncertificated head or sole teacher or assistant; but not so as to reduce the annual salary below £80.
