An Act to amend "The Employment of Females and Others Act, 1881." [6th November, 1884.

WHEREAS it is desirable to amend "The Employment of Females and Others Act, 1881," hereinafter called "the said Act":

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Employment of Females and Others Act 1881 Amendment Act, 1884."

2. Section two of the said Act is hereby amended as follows: "Child" means a boy or girl between the ages of twelve and fourteen years.

3. Section eleven of the said Act is hereby amended as follows: The words "during working hours" at the end of the said section are hereby struck out.
