Title 1. Short Title

#### 1960, No. 31

# An Act to amend the Emergency Regulations Act 1939 [17 October 1960]

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1. Short Title—This Act may be cited as the Emergency Regulations Amendment Act 1960, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Emergency Regulations Act 1939\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

2. Emergency regulations continued in force—The emergency regulations specified in the Schedule to this Act, unless they are sooner revoked by the Governor-General in Council or by any Act, shall continue in force until the thirty-first day of December, nineteen hundred and sixty-one, and shall then expire.

3. Repeal—The Emergency Regulations Amendment Act 1959 is hereby repealed.
