The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:

1 Title

- (1) This Act is the Fair Trading Amendment Act 2000.
- (2) In this Act, the Fair Trading Act 1986 is called “the principal Act”.

2 Commencement

This Act comes into force on the day after the date on which it receives the Royal assent.

3 False representations

Section 13 of the principal Act is amended by—

- (a) omitting the words “Falsely represent” in each place where they occur, and substituting in each case the words “make a false or misleading representation”; and
 - (b) inserting in the heading, after the word “False”, the words “or misleading”.
