AN ACT to amend "The Harbours Act, 1878." Title.
[26th September, 1904.]

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Harbours Act 1878 Amendment Act, 1904." Short Title.

2. Where any land is taken by the Governor for any purpose save for road or railway purposes under powers granted by "The Harbours Act, 1878," the Board shall be entitled to receive compensation for any land so taken, and such compensation shall be ascertained and settled in the manner provided by "The Public Works Act, 1894." Compensation for land taken.

3. Section one hundred and forty-four of "The Harbours Act, 1878," is hereby amended accordingly. Repeal.
