AN ACT to transfer Land in Town of Havelock, Otago.
[8th October, 1906.]

Title.

WHEREAS Sections Nos. 3, 4, and 5, Block XX, Town of Havelock, in the Land District of Otago, are a reserve for an athenæum: And whereas they are no longer required for that purpose, and it is desirable that the said land should be added to the Waitahuna School site:

Preamble.

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act is “The Havelock Athenæum and Mechanics’ Institute Incorporation Act 1877 Amendment Act, 1906.”

Short Title.

2. The purpose for which Sections 3, 4, and 5 aforesaid were reserved is hereby changed from a site for an athenæum to that of a school-site, and the said land is hereby vested in the Education Board of the District of Otago.

Land to vest in Education Board.

3. “The Havelock Athenæum and Mechanics’ Institute Incorporation Act, 1877,” is hereby amended by repealing the words “Sections 3, 4, and 5 of Block XX” in the Schedule thereto.
