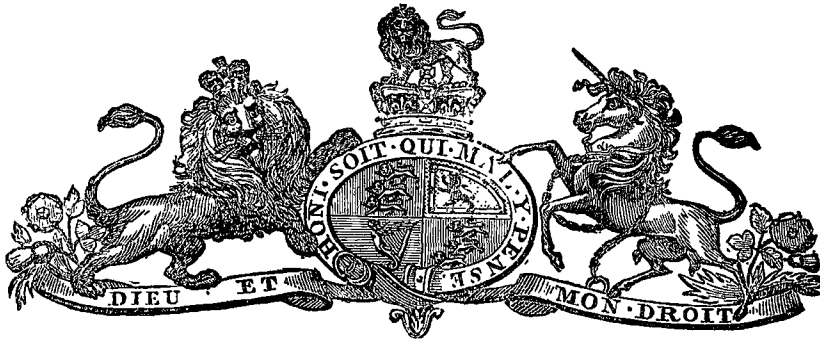

AN ACT to authorize the Corporation of the City of Auckland to consolidate certain Loans.

[19th December, 1879.]

WHEREAS under and by virtue of the provisions of Part XXI. of an Act of the General Assembly of New Zealand, No. XXIV., made and passed in the thirty-first year of the reign of Her present Majesty, shortly intituled "The Municipal Corporations Act, 1867," the Council of the Borough of Auckland did, by resolution dated the twenty-third day of October, one thousand eight hundred and seventy-one, borrow the sum of twenty thousand pounds, and caused the debentures

North by Suburban Section fifty-five on the said plan, three thousand five hundred links ; towards the East by Suburban Section forty-seven two thousand links, by a line crossing the Taradale and Meanee Road one hundred links, and by Suburban Section forty-eight one thousand seven hundred links ; towards the South by other portions of Suburban Sections fifty-two and fifty-three, three thousand five hundred links ; and towards the West by a public road, three thousand eight hundred links : be all the aforesaid linkages more or less ; as the same is delineated on the plan deposited in the Survey Office, Napier.
