Title.	AN ACT to amend "The Havelock Commonage Act, 1877." [8th September, 1894.]
Preamble.	WHEREAS it is expedient to amend "The Havelock Commonage Act, 1877" (hereinafter called "the said Act"): BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—
Short Title.	1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Havelock Commonage Act 1877 Amendment Act, 1894."
Second section of "The Havelock Commonage Act 1877," amended.	2. The following alteration shall be made in the second section of the said Act: namely, in the third line thereof, before the name "Robert," to strike out the word "and," and after the name "Sutherland," the following names shall be inserted: "Frederick Ellis, Duncan McTaggart, Thomas Fisher, and Robert York."
