An Act to incorporate the Township of Campbell-[29th October, 1878.] town.

Incorporation of CAMPBELLTOWN.

THEREAS it is expedient to make provisions for the incorporation Presmble. of the inhabitants of the Government Township of Campbelltown and its environs, in that part of the Provincial District of Otago formerly called Southland, other than are contained in "The Municipal Corporations Act, 1876:"

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same,

as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act shall be "The Incorporation of Short Title.

Campbelltown Act, 1878."

2. Notwithstanding anything contained in section seventeen of Township of Camp-"The Municipal Corporations Act, 1876," the Governor may, by Proclamation, declare the lands described in the Schedule hereto a borough under "The Municipal Corporations Act, 1876," subject to the following across the seventeen of Township of Campbelltown declared in Seventeen of C ing conditions:—

(1.) That a petition is presented to the Governor, signed by not less than fifty resident householders within the said area, praying the Governor to constitute the same a borough under "The Municipal Corporations Act, 1876:"

(2.) That no petition signed by fifty or more resident householders within the said area is presented to the Governor within two months after the presentation of such petition praying him not to assent to the prayer thereof:

(3.) That all the requirements of the Municipal Corporations Act (except those contained in subsections two, three, and six, section seventeen of the said Act) shall have been complied with.

3. No Crown land shall be reserved for or be granted to the said Borough not to Borough of Campbelltown under section three hundred and fifty of receive land endowment. "The Municipal Corporations Act, 1876."

ALL that parcel of land in the Provincial District of Otago, bounded towards the North by the Bluff Harbour; towards the East, South, and West by Foveaux Strait; and towards the North-west by the south-eastern boundary line of Section No. 19, Block I., Campbelltown Hundred, produced from sea to sea.
