Title. AN ACT to amend the Law relating to the Inspection of Machinery.
[5th November, 1898.]

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short Title.

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Inspection of Machinery Acts Amendment Act, 1898."

Constitution of

amended.

2. The Minister may from time to time appoint any fit person to be a member of the Board of Examiners constituted under section five of "The Inspection of Machinery Act Amendment Act, 1894," but any person so appointed shall act as a member only whilst the Inspecting Engineer of the Mines Department or the Chief Inspector of Machinery is absent from Wellington, or is unable to attend the meeting of the Board.

Evidence of
authority to act.

3. The fact of the person so appointed acting as a member of the Board shall be sufficient evidence of his authority so to do.
