**An Act to amend the Immigration Restriction Act 1908**  
[2 October 1958]

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

**1. Short Title**—This Act may be cited as the *Immigration Restriction Amendment Act 1958*, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the *Immigration Restriction Act 1908*.

**2. Penalty for offences**—(1) Section eleven of the *Immigration Restriction Amendment Act 1920* is hereby amended by omitting the words “one year”, and substituting the words “three months”.

(2) Section six of the *Immigration Restriction Amendment Act 1951* is hereby amended by omitting the words “twelve months”, and substituting the words “three months”.

**3. Repealing provisions as to oath of obedience**—The following enactments are hereby repealed:

- (a) Part II of the *Immigration Restriction Amendment Act 1920*;
  - (b) Section two of the *Immigration Restriction Amendment Act 1923*.
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
