An Act to amend the Immigration Restriction Act 1908 [2 October 1958]

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1. Short Title—This Act may be cited as the Immigration Restriction Amendment Act 1958, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Immigration Restriction Act 1908.
- 2. Penalty for offences—(1) Section eleven of the Immigration Restriction Amendment Act 1920 is hereby amended by omitting the words "one year", and substituting the words "three months".
- (2) Section six of the Immigration Restriction Amendment Act 1951 is hereby amended by omitting the words "twelve months", and substituting the words "three months".
- 3. Repealing provisions as to oath of obedience—The following enactments are hereby repealed:
 - (a) Part II of the Immigration Restriction Amendment Act 1920:
 - (b) Section two of the Immigration Restriction Amendment Act 1923.
