AN ACT to apply a Sum of Money out of the Public Account to the Service of the Year ending the Thirty-first Day of March, One thousand eight hundred and ninety-six. Title. [29th June, 1895.]

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

| <p>1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Imprest Supply Act, 1895."</p> <p>2. In addition to the sums mentioned in the Civil List Act and other Acts, there may be issued and applied, by way of imprest, towards making good the supply granted to Her Majesty for the service of the year ending the thirty-first day of March, one thousand eight hundred and ninety-six,—</p> <p>(1.) Out of the Public Account, any sums of money not exceeding in the whole two hundred and ninety-three thousand pounds, as set forth in the First Schedule hereto; and also</p> <p>(2.) Out of the respective accounts mentioned in the Second Schedule hereto, the respective sums therein set forth, amounting in the whole to nine thousand pounds.</p> <p>3.
