BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :---

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Imprest Supply Act, Short Title. 1896."

2. In addition to the sums mentioned in the Civil List Act and £332,000 and £9,000 other Acts, there may be issued and applied, by way of imprest, advanced on imprest towards towards making good the supply granted to Her Majesty for the service of year service of the year ending the thirty-first day of March, one thou- ending 31st March, 1897. sand eight hundred and ninety-seven,---

- (1.) Out of the Public Account, any sums of money not ex
 - ceeding in the whole three hundred and thirty-two thousand pounds, as set forth in the First Schedule hereto; and
- (2.) Out of the respective accounts mentioned in the Second Schedule hereto, the respective sums therein set forth. not exceeding in the whole nine thousand pounds.

3. The aforesaid sums shall be charged in the manner hereafter Such sums to be to be expressed in any Act or Acts passed in this present session of charged as expressed in Acts to be passed Parliament for appropriating the public revenues of the colony for by Parliament. the year ending the thirty-first day of March, one thousand eight hundred and ninety-seven.
