An Act to amend the Law Practitioners Act 1982

[13 March 1985

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1. Short Title—This Act may be cited as the Law Practitioners Amendment Act (No. 2) 1985, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Law Practitioners Act 1982 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).
- 2. Regulations for audit of trust accounts—Section 91 (1) of the principal Act is hereby amended by inserting, after paragraph (i), the following paragraph:
 - "(ia) Prescribing the circumstances (if any), and the conditions subject to which, any trust account may be kept in a name other than that by which the client is usually known; and requiring trust accounts to be kept in all other circumstances in the names by which the clients are usually known:".

This Act is administered in the Department of Justice.
