

WHEREAS the inhabitants of the Town of Napier have been Preamble. VV created a Corporation, under the name of "The Mayor, Councillors, and Burgesses of the Borough of Napier:" And whereas it is expedient that the lands described in the First and Second Schedules hereunder written should be vested in the said Corporation, for the purposes and with the powers hereinafter mentioned:

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as

1. The Short Title of this Act shall be "The Napier Borough short Title. Endowments Act, 1876."

2. All the lands described in the First and Second Schedules in Lands in First and this Act are hereby declared to be an endowment for the use benefit Second Schedules be endowment for

and improvement of the Borough of Napier.

3. Such of the said lands as before the passing of this Act shall All lands heretofore have been granted by the Crown, and shall have been vested in the dent of Hawke's Bay Superintendent of the Province of Hawke's Bay, whether subject to be vested in Mayor, any trusts or for any purposes or not, shall, from and after the passing Councillors, and Burgesses of Napier. of this Act, vest for an estate in the fee-simple, without any conveyance, in "The Mayor, Councillors, and Burgesses of the Borough

of Napier" and their successors, for such purposes as are mentioned in the second section of this Act, and freed and absolutely discharged from any trusts or purposes to which the same were made subject by the grants under which the same are held by the Superintendent; and such of the said lands as shall not before the passing of this Act have been granted by the Crown shall, on the passing of this Act, be granted to "The Mayor, Councillors, and Burgesses of the Borough of Napier," for the purposes mentioned in the second section of this Act.

4. "The Mayor, Councillors, and Burgesses of the Borough of Napier," in respect of the lands described in the First Schedule, and any other lands for the time being held by them under the provisions of this Act, may from time to time exercise all or any of the powers following that is to say

following, that is to say,—

(1.) May raise money by mortgage or debenture without power of sale, and subject to and with such powers covenants and stipulations as they may think fit.

(2.) May demise or lease for any term not exceeding thirty-five years, without fine or foregift, or let from year to year or otherwise, and with or without any special conditions.

(3.) May lay out roads through the said lands.

(4.) May dedicate any part or parts of such lands for public or for recreation purposes.

(5.) May erect any buildings on the said lands or on any part thereof.

5. The said Mayor, Councillors, and Burgesses of the Borough of Napier may from time to time, in respect of the land described in the Second Schedule, exercise all or any of the powers following, but none other, that is to say,—

(1.) May enclose, lay out, and plant the same or any part

thereof.

(2.) May dedicate such land or any part thereof for public or for recreation purposes

6. Nothing contained in this Act shall prejudicially affect any

6. Nothing contained in this Act shall prejudicially affect any lien mortgage or encumbrance heretofore made or now subsisting in respect of the said lands or any of them.

SCHEDULES.

FIRST SCHEDULE.

RESERVES, BOROUGH OF NAPIER.

RESERVE originally set apart as a site for Town Hall and Court House, containing 5 acres 3 roods, more or less. Bounded towards the North-east by Faraday Street, 500 links; towards the South-east and South by Wellesley Road, 750 links and 925 links respectively; and towards the North-west by Carlyle Street, 1550 links.

Reserve Section No. 576, Town of Napier, containing 2 roods 26 poles, more or less. Bounded on the North-east by a road, 594 links; on the West by Wellesley Road, 549

links; on the South by Section No. 577, 242 links.

Reserve Section No. 587, Town of Napier, containing 1 rood 8 poles, more or less.

Bounded on the North by Hardinge Road, 146 links; on the East by Section No. 478, 213 links; on the South by Waghorn Street, 146 links; on the West by Section No. 479, 207 links.

Section No. 598, Town of Napier, containing 1 rood, more or less. Bounded on the North by Section No. 597, 228 links; on the East by Crown lands, 110 links; on the South by a reserve, Section No. 599, 228 links; on the West by the West Quay, 110

Section No. 600, Town of Napier, containing 1 rood, more or less. Bounded on the North by a reserve, Section No. 599, 228 links; on the East by Crown lands, 110 links; on the South by Section No. 601, 228 links; on the West by the West Quay, 110 links.

Section No. 610, Town of Napier, containing 1 rood 12 poles more or less. Bounded on the North by Lever Street, 331 links; on the East by Colin Street, 100 links; on the South by Section No. 611, 323 links; on the West by a public road, 100

Section No. 613, Town of Napier, containing 1 rood, more or less. Bounded on the North by Section No. 612, 304 links; on the East by Colin Street, 85 links; on

Reserve known as "Clive Square," containing 3 acres 32 poles, more or less. on the North-east by a public road or street, 800 links; on the South-east by Thackeray Street, 400 links; on the South-west by a public road or street, 800 links; and on the North-west by Tennyson Street, 400 links.

Reserve for Botanical Gardens, containing 12 acres, more or less. Bounded towards the North by Goldsmith Road and Chaucer Road; towards the East by the Burialground Reserve; towards the South by Spenser Road; towards the West by Lawrence Road and Spenser Road.
