AN ACT to change the Purposes for which certain Lands in the Borough of New Plymouth are held by the Mayor, Councillors, and Burgesses. Title.  
[28th October, 1898.]

WHEREAS the Mayor, Councillors, and Burgesses of the Borough of New Plymouth are desirous that the purposes for which certain lands in the said borough are vested in them should be changed: Preamble.

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act is “The New Plymouth Borough Reserves and Street Exchanges Act, 1898.” Short Title.

2. From and after the passing of this Act the parcels of land in the Borough of New Plymouth described in the First Column of the Schedule hereto, now held by the Mayor, Councillors, and Burgesses of the Borough of New Plymouth for the purposes specified opposite thereto respectively in the Second Column of the said Schedule, shall be held by the Mayor, Councillors, and Burgesses of the Borough of New Plymouth for the purposes specified opposite thereto respectively in the Third Column of the said Schedule. Purposes for which lands described in Schedule held changed.
