**An Act to amend the New Zealand Constitution Act 1852**

[27 November 1970]

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

**1. Short Title and commencement**—(1) This Act may be cited as the New Zealand Constitution Amendment Act 1970, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the New Zealand Constitution Act 1852 of the United Kingdom Parliament (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

(2) This Act shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of April 1957.

**2. Sections 64 and 65 of principal Act repealed**—Sections 64 and 65 of the principal Act are hereby repealed.
