An Act to amend the Police Act 1958

[13 January 1981

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1. Short Title—This Act may be cited as the Police Amendment Act 1980, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Police Act 1958 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

2. Period of notice of resignation or retirement reduced—(1) Section 16 (1) of the principal Act is hereby amended by omitting the expression “1 month’s”, and substituting the expression “14 days”.

(2) Section 28 (1) of the principal Act is hereby amended by adding the following proviso:

“Provided that the member may, with the consent of the Commissioner, waive his right to notice and retire immediately.”

3. Pensions in respect of death or disablement—Section 42 (1) of the principal Act is hereby amended by inserting, after the words “attributable to”, the words “or aggravated or precipitated by”.
