Title.

AN ACT to amend "The Sheep Act, 1878."

[15th September, 1882.]

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short Title.

Section 23 of "The Sheep Act, 1878," suspended in Marlborough District.

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Sheep Act Amendment Act, 1882."
2. The operation of section twenty-three of "The Sheep Act, 1878," shall be deemed to have been suspended in the District of Marlborough from the first day of January, one thousand eight hundred and eighty-two, until the thirty-first day of August, one thousand eight hundred and eighty-two.
