The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:

- 1 Title**
This Act is the Subordinate Legislation (Confirmation and Validation) Act 2000.
- 2 Commencement**
This Act comes into force on the day after the date on which it receives the Royal assent.

*Effect of validations***9 Effect of validations**

The validations effected by sections 6 to 8 are for the purpose only of preventing the expiry of the enactments validated; and do not—

- (a) express an intention to give legislative force to the provisions of those enactments; or
- (b) apply to any reason for invalidating any of those enactments; or
- (c) override any presumption that would otherwise apply to any of those enactments.
