AN ACT to Amend the Supply Regulations Act, 1947. Title. [21st October, 1949

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:---

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the Supply Regu- short Title and lations Amendment Act, 1949, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Supply Regulations Act, 1947, No. 65 1947 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

(2) This Act shall come into force on the thirty-first day of December, nineteen hundred and forty-nine.

2. (1) The supply regulations specified in the First Revocation Schedule to this Act are hereby revoked.

(2) The Schedule to the principal Act is hereby regulations. amended by repealing so much thereof as relates to the regulations hereby revoked.

(3) The Schedule to the principal Act is hereby further amended by repealing so much thereof as relates to the Foodstuffs Emergency Regulations 1939 (revoked by the Foodstuffs Emergency Regulations Revocation Order 1949).

3. The supply regulations specified in the Second Schedule to this Act, unless they are sooner revoked by the Governor-General in Council or by any Act, shall continue in force until the thirty-first day of December, nineteen hundred and fifty, and shall then expire.

4. Section nine of the principal Act is hereby amended by repealing subsection one (as substituted by section four of the Supply Regulations Amendment Act, 1948), and substituting the following subsection:—

"(1) This Act shall continue in force until the thirty-first day of December, nineteen hundred and fifty, and shall then expire."

5. The Supply Regulations Amendment Act, 1948, is hereby repealed.
