**An Act to amend the Tariff Act 1988**

[8 August 1990]

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of New Zealand as follows:

**1. Short Title and commencement**—(1) This Act may be cited as the Tariff Amendment Act 1990, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Tariff Act 1988 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

(2) Except as provided in section 3 (6) of this Act, this Act shall come into force on the day on which it receives the Royal assent.

**2. Fees**—The principal Act is hereby amended by inserting, after section 16, the following section:

“16A. The Governor-General may from time to time, by Order in Council, make regulations prescribing the fees to be paid in respect of—

“(a) Applications for any approval under section 8 (1) of this Act in respect of the entry of goods—

“(i) Of any of the classes specified in Part II of the Tariff; or

“(ii) In any of the circumstances specified in Part II of the Tariff:

“(b) Applications for any withdrawal or modification, under section 8 (2) of this Act, of any approval granted under section 8 (1) of this Act.”

**3. Tariff amended**—(1) The First Schedule to the principal Act is hereby amended by inserting, immediately before the

heading "SECTION I" that appears after the Notes at the beginning of the Tariff, the following heading:

**"PART I**

**"THE STANDARD TARIFF".**

(2) The First Schedule to the principal Act is hereby further amended by repealing so much of Part I of the Tariff as relates to items 2207.20.29, 2710.00.11, 2710.00.19, 2710.00.32, 2710.00.38, 2710.00.63, 2710.00.67, 2905.11.09, 3606.10.09, 3823.90.29, 8703.21.19, 8703.22.09, 8703.23.09, 8703.24.09, 8703.31.09, 8703.32.09, 8703.33.09, 8703.90.09, 8704.21.11, 8704.31.11, and 8704.90.11, and substituting the items, rates of duty, and statistical keys set out in the Schedule to this Act.

(3) The First Schedule to the principal Act is hereby further amended by inserting in the list of terms, abbreviations, and symbols appearing in Note 2 at the beginning of the Tariff, in its appropriate alphabetical order, the following item:

"Pb chemical symbol for lead".

(4) The First Schedule to the principal Act is hereby further amended by inserting in Chapter 27 of Part I of the Tariff, after New Zealand Note 2, the following note:

"3. The lead (Pb) content of motor fuel is to be measured by application of either one of the standard methods (currently designated A.S.T.M. D 3116 or A.S.T.M. D 3341) as set down by the American Society for Testing and Materials."

(5) The Finance Act 1989 is hereby consequentially amended by repealing section 25 (2) (a) and the Second Schedule.

(6) This section shall be deemed to have come into force on the 25th day of July 1990.

**4. Validation of certain tariff concessions**—All approvals, and all modifications or withdrawals of approvals, given or made or purported to be given or made—

(a) During the period commencing with the 1st day of December 1988 and ending with the date of commencement of this section by the Minister of Commerce pursuant to section 8 of the principal Act in respect of goods referred to in Reference Number 25 of Part II of the Tariff; and

(b) By the Minister of Customs—

(i) During the period commencing with the 1st day of January 1988 and ending with the 30th day of November 1988 pursuant to section 120 (4) of the

Customs Act 1966 (as substituted by section 6 (1) of the Customs Amendment Act (No. 4) 1987); or

(ii) At any time before the 1st day of January 1988 pursuant to section 120 (5) of the Customs Act 1966 (as substituted by section 5 (1) of the Customs Acts Amendment Act (No. 2) 1977),—

in respect of goods referred to in Reference Number 25 of Part II of the Second Schedule to the Customs Act 1966,—

are hereby validated and declared to have been lawfully done notwithstanding that any such approval, modification, or withdrawal may not have been recommended by the Minister of Health.
