

AN ACT to amend "The Thames Borough Loans Conversion Act, Title. 1898." [20th October, 1900.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :---

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Thames Borough Loans short Title. Conversion Act 1898 Amendment Act, 1900."

2. The Council of the Borough of Thames shall have power Power to borough and are hereby authorised to pay any sum or sums of money by way to pay money in respect of converof premium or compensation, or other charges incident thereto, in sion. respect of the conversions of the two outstanding loans referred to in "The Thames Borough Loans Conversion Act, 1898," or either of them.

3. All sums payable under the last preceding section, and also Moneys may be all costs of issuing conversion debentures under the last-mentioned paid out of sinking Act, and all charges incident to the conversion or conversions and other operations connected therewith, may be paid out of the sinking fund or sinking funds set free by such conversion.

4. The sinking fund or sinking funds released as mentioned in Sinking fund may section six of "The Thames Borough Loans Conversion Act, 1898," or the residue thereof respectively, shall and may be applied in any manner and for any purpose the Council of the said borough may think fit.
