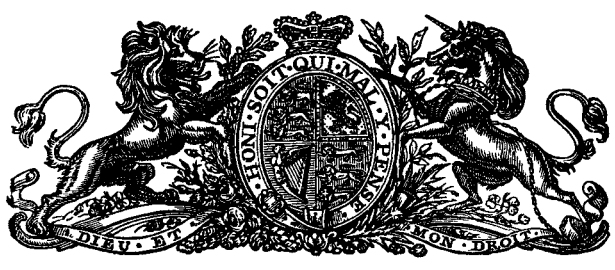

AN ACT to apply out of the Consolidated Fund the sum of £100,000 to the Service of the year ending the thirtieth day of June one thousand eight hundred and sixty-nine. [21st July 1868.]

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows—

1. The Short Title of this Act shall be "The Imprest Supply Act 1868."

2. Out of the Consolidated Fund there may be issued and applied towards making good the Supply granted to Her Majesty by way of Imprest for the service of the year ending the thirtieth day of June one thousand eight hundred and sixty-nine in addition to the sums mentioned in the Civil List Act and other Acts any sums of money not exceeding one hundred thousand pounds to be charged in the manner hereafter to be expressed in any Act or Acts passed in this present session of Parliament for appropriating the Consolidated Revenues of the Colony for the year ending the thirtieth day of June one thousand eight hundred and sixty-nine.
