BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:-

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Imprest Supply Act, Short Title.

1896 (No. 5)."

2. In addition to all sums otherwise granted, there may be £300,000 advanced issued and applied, by way of imprest, towards making good the on imprest towards supply granted to Her Majesty for the service of the year ending ending 31st March, the thirty-first day of March, one thousand eight hundred and 1897. ninety-seven.-

Out of the respective funds and accounts (being part of the Public Account) specified in the Schedule hereto, any sums of money not exceeding in the whole three hundred thousand pounds, as set forth in that Schedule.

3. The aforesaid sums shall be charged in the manner hereafter such sums to be to be expressed in any Act or Acts passed in this present session of charged as expressed in Acts to Parliament for appropriating the public revenues of the colony for be passed by the year ending the thirty-first day of March, one thousand eight Parliament. hundred and ninety-seven.
