AN ACT to apply a Sum of Money out of the Public Account to the Service of the Year ending the Thirty-first day of March, One thousand eight hundred and ninety-seven. Title.

[24th September, 1896.]

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act is “The Imprest Supply Act, 1896 (No. 5).” Short Title.

2. In addition to all sums otherwise granted, there may be issued and applied, by way of imprest, towards making good the supply granted to Her Majesty for the service of the year ending the thirty-first day of March, one thousand eight hundred and ninety-seven,— £300,000 advanced on imprest towards service of year ending 31st March, 1897.

Out of the respective funds and accounts (being part of the Public Account) specified in the Schedule hereto, any sums of money not exceeding in the whole three hundred thousand pounds, as set forth in that Schedule.

3. The aforesaid sums shall be charged in the manner hereafter to be expressed in any Act or Acts passed in this present session of Parliament for appropriating the public revenues of the colony for the year ending the thirty-first day of March, one thousand eight hundred and ninety-seven. Such sums to be charged as expressed in Acts to be passed by Parliament.
