**AN ACT to amend the Law relating to** Title.  
**Juries. [14th December 1863.]**

**BE IT ENACTED** by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled and by authority thereof as follows :—

I. This Act shall be called "The Jury Law Amendment Act 1863." Short Title.

II. No person shall be liable to serve as a Juror for a longer time than six consecutive days at any one sitting of the Supreme Court Provided that any such Juror shall be bound to continue his services as a Juror upon any case or action which at the expiration of the said period may have been partly heard by him until the conclusion thereof. Duration of service of Jurors.

III. No Member of a Provincial Council shall be liable to serve as a Juror during the Session of the Council of which he may be a Member. Provincial Councillors not liable to serve as Jurors.
