AN ACT to amend the Law relating to Title. [14th December 1863.]

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled and by authority thereof as follows:--

- I. This Act shall be called "The Jury Law Amendment Short Title. Act 1863."
- II. No person shall be liable to serve as a Juror for a Duration of service of longer time than six consecutive days at any one sitting of the Jurors. Supreme Court Provided that any such Juror shall be bound to continue his services as a Juror upon any case or action which at the expiration of the said period may have been partly heard by him until the conclusion thereof.

III. No Member of a Provincial Council shall be liable to Provincial Council serve as a Juror during the Session of the Council of which he lors not liable to serve as Jurors. may be a Member.
