

## ANALYSIS.

## AN ACT to amend "The Municipal Corporations Title. Waterworks Act, 1872." [19th August, 1873.]

E IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :-

1. The Short Title of this Act shall be "The Municipal Corpora- short Title. tions Waterworks Act Amendment Act, 1873."

2. This Act shall be construed and read with and as part of "The Interpretation. Municipal Corporations Waterworks Act, 1872," which is hereafter referred to as "the said Act."

3. The time at which the debentures and mortgages under the Debentures, &c., may said Act made after the passing of this Act may be made redeemable shall be any time not exceeding fifty years from the issuing or making fifty years instead of of the same respectively, as the Council may determine, instead of any thirty years. term not exceeding thirty years, as provided by the eighteenth section of the said Act.

4. The Council may not only offer for sale such debentures as Debentures may be prescribed by the twenty-second section of the said Act, but the given in exchange Council may, if it thinks fit, give such debentures or any of them in works purchased exchange or as payment for any waterworks or other property pur- by Council. chased or acquired by such Council under the provisions contained in the said Act, to any vendor who shall agree to receive the same in exchange or as payment.
