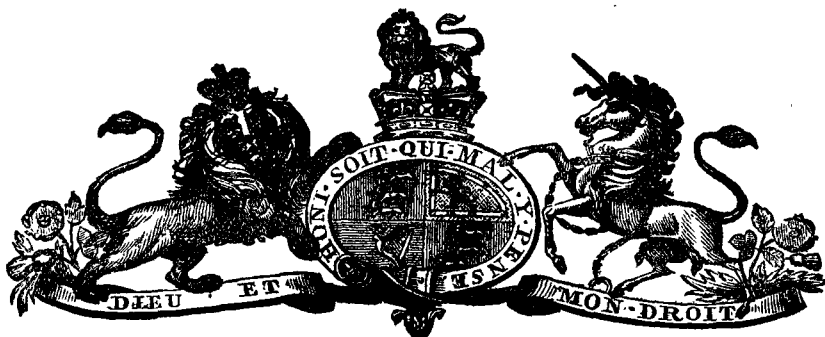

AN ACT to amend "The Privileges Act, 1866." Title.
 [28th October, 1878.]

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act shall be "The Privileges Act 1866 Amendment Act, 1878." Short Title.
2. The Schedule to "The Privileges Act, 1866" (hereinafter called "the said Act"), shall be amended by adding thereto the words "The Clerk-Assistant of the Legislative Council." Schedule amended.
3. Clauses seven, eight, nine, and twelve of the said Act shall be amended by adding the words "or Acting Speaker," whenever the word "Speaker" is used in the said clauses immediately after the said word Speaker, and the said clauses shall be read and interpreted in all respects as if the said words "or Acting Speaker" had been originally introduced and formed part of the said clauses. Clauses 7, 8, 9, and 12 amended.
