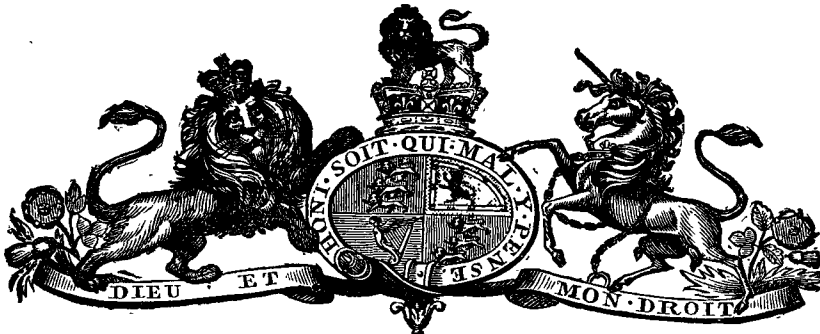

1. Short Title.

2. Municipal Corporation of Port Chalmers may borrow money for waterworks.

AN ACT to authorize the Municipal Council of the Town of Port Chalmers to raise Money for the purpose of constructing Waterworks for the supply of the Town and the Shipping of the Port with Water. [15th September, 1873.]

WHEREAS it is expedient to authorize the Municipal Council of the Town of Port Chalmers to raise money for the purpose of constructing waterworks for the supply of the town and the shipping of the port with water as hereinafter mentioned:

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act shall be "The Port Chalmers Waterworks Act, 1873."

2. The Municipal Council of the Town of Port Chalmers may borrow any sum or sums of money not exceeding in the whole the sum of fifteen thousand pounds, and may secure the repayment of the same with interest in manner provided by "The Municipal Corporations Waterworks Act, 1872," and may apply the same in the construction or purchase of waterworks, under the provisions of the said Act, for the supply of the Town of Port Chalmers and the shipping of the port with water: Provided always that no money shall be raised under the provisions of this Act until the undertaking shall have become a duly authorized undertaking within the provisions of the said Act.
