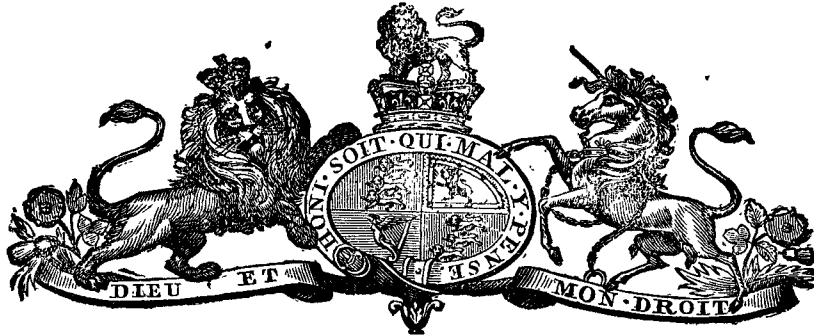

Title.

- 2. Provincial Council may repeal Ordinance or Resolution passed by such Council.

AN ACT to amend "The Volunteers Land Act, 1865." [2nd October, 1873.] Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act shall be "The Volunteers Land Act 1865 Amendment Act, 1873." Short Title.

2. It shall be lawful for any Provincial Council to repeal rescind or amend any Ordinance or Resolution passed by such Council authorizing the grant of remission certificates to Volunteers under the said Act or amending Act: Provided always that such repeal rescission or amendment shall not affect such Volunteers as at the time thereof shall have fulfilled one or more years of the term of service in respect of which remission certificates were authorized to be granted by the Ordinance or Resolution so repealed rescinded or amended. Provincial Council may repeal Ordinance or Resolution passed by such Council.

3. All claims for remission to which the applicants are now entitled, and all claims for exercise of scrip already issued, will be barred, unless made within twelve months of the passing of this Act. Claims for remission and exercise of scrip to be made within twelve months.
