AN ACT to Amend the War Pensions and Allowances (Mercantile Marine) Act, 1940.

[17th November, 1950

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the War Pensions and Allowances (Mercantile Marine) Amendment Act, 1950, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the War Pensions and Allowances (Mercantile Marine) Act, 1940 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

Short Title and commencement.

(2) This Act shall be deemed to have come into force on the eighth day of May, nineteen hundred and fifty.

2. (1) The principal Act is hereby amended by repealing the First, Second, and Third Schedules (as set out in the Schedule to the War Pensions and Allowances (Mercantile Marine) Amendment Act, 1949), and substituting therefor respectively the First, Second, and Third Schedules set out in the Schedule to this Act.

(2) Section two of the War Pensions and Allowances (Mercantile Marine) Amendment Act, 1949, and the Schedule to that Act are hereby repealed.
