A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend "The Administration Act 1879 Amendment Title Act, 1885."

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in
5 Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Administration Acts
Amendment Act, 1890." Short Title.

2. "The Administration Act 1879 Amendment Act, 1885," shall
10 be read and construed as if the word "separate," wherever it occurs
before the word "property," had been omitted therefrom. Interpretation.

3. The provisions of this Act shall extend and apply to the
estates remaining unadministered of all married women who have
15 died after the coming into operation of "The Married Women's
Property Act, 1884." Application of Act
to deceased married
women's estates.
