BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand 5 in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Abattoirs and Slaughter-Short Title. houses Act Amendment Act, 1896."

2. (1.) In any proceedings against any person for permitting or No liability if suffering drainage to flow from any abattoirs or slaughterhouse into drainage does not any stream running through a borough, it shall be a sufficient defence if he satisfies the Court that the stream is not thereby polluted.

(2.) Section five of "The Abattoirs and Slaughterhouses Act

Amendment Act, 1895," shall be read subject to this section.

An Acr to abolish Capital Punishment.

Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as fol-5 lows :-

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Abolition of Capital Short Title. Punishment Act, 1896."

2. Section one hundred and sixty-seven of "The Criminal Code Repeal.

Act, 1893," is hereby repealed.

3. From and after the date of this Act coming into force, every Punishment for one who commits murder shall, upon conviction thereof, be sentenced murder. to imprisonment with hard labour for the full term of his or her natural life.
